School Profile 2023-2024

Our School: The American College of Sofia (ACS) is **the oldest American educational institution outside the U.S.** Founded in 1860, the College was closed in 1942 and re-opened in 1992. **School Mission:** ACS integrates the values and best practices of American pedagogy with the rich educational traditions of Bulgaria and Europe. We seek to develop critical thinking, lifelong intellectual curiosity, leadership, and collaboration among multi-talented students of various social, cultural, economic, and geographic backgrounds.

Our Students: ACS is home to 953 students, Grades 8-12. Admission exam invitations are extended to candidates with 5.00 GPA and above (21% of candidates held a 6.00 GPA in 2023; the mid 50% held a GPA of 5.50-5.93). Admission is then offered based on admission exam rank. The acceptance rate is 35% (the top 266 of 755 exam-takers). Yield is 69%. Bulgarians make up 96% of our students (90% from Sofia, 10% from outside of Sofia) and international students make up 4%, from Columbia, Denmark, France, Greece, India, Israel, Poland, Russia, Spain, Ukraine, UK and the USA. Financial assistance is central to our mission, ensuring diversity within our student body and fostering an inclusive atmosphere at school. 30% of students receive financial aid including 6 per year who receive merit & needbased full scholarships. Tuition for Bulgarian students is 9,120€. Tuition for international students is 20,720€, which includes the IB Diploma Program.

A high GPA is important, but it is only one aspect of what we consider a meaningful educational experience. At ACS, we focus on developing not only excellent scholars, but also on cultivating the unique talents and curiosities of our students through a strong curricular and co-curricular experience.



Our Faculty: Faculty at ACS are distinguished professionals in their areas of expertise and come from a variety of cultural backgrounds: 14 hold doctoral degrees and 69 hold masters degrees. 40% of the faculty are international. ACS faculty provide a unique and enriching blend of pedagogies to support international and Bulgarian curricula.

Our Curriculum: ACS is accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools (MSA), the International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO) and the Bulgarian Ministry of Education and Science, which designated the College an Innovative School in 2017. Instruction at ACS is in English except for other languages and Bulgarian history. The rigorous *college-prep. curriculum* prepares all students for *research-university level of study*. In grades 9 & 10, all courses are required. In grades 11 & 12, Bulgarian students enter the Bulgarian Diploma Program (academic stream) and choose one of the following profiles: Humanities, Foreign Languages, Mathematics & Physics, Software & Hardware Sciences, Natural Sciences or Entrepreneurship. *In each profile, the multiple courses of advanced study are all required*. International students enter the IB Diploma Program and choose 3-4 higher level subjects, including English A Literature, which is required, and 2-3 standard level subjects. (**Please note: Bulgarian students cannot enroll in the IB Diploma at ACS.)** All students create a CAS (Creativity, Action, Service) portfolio yearly representing a minimum of 75 hours of extracurricular activities. Students who complete their ACS classes in one of the above programs and the CAS portfolio requirements also earn an American High School Diploma. Typically, 100% of students earn the American Diploma and the Bulgarian or IB Diploma. The ACS high school diplomas are accepted throughout the EU and around the world.








Diploma Requirements

In Grades 9 & 10, Bulgarian and international students follow almost the same ACS curriculum. In Grades 11 & 12, the Bulgarian students follow the Bulgarian Diploma Program. Only international students can follow the IB Diploma Program. Students earn an American High School Diploma by passing their ACS classes in one of the above programs, and completing their Creativity, Activity & Service (CAS) Portfolios. Typically, 100% of students earn the American Diploma and the Bulgarian or IB Diploma.

On average, 92% of ACS seniors apply to non-Bulgarian colleges and universities each year. ACS students from the classes of 2021, 2022 and 2023 were accepted at the following colleges and universities, often times having been awarded significant scholarship or financial aid from US institutions.
